Finance.

A copy of the School Finance Report as circulated to the Board. The Principal informed the Board that the Accounts Section in CMETB were satisfied that all Largy College accounts are in order.

The costs related to the current sewage works do not come out of the school budget.

Student Matters:

Sharon informed the Board of the following:

- ASD Unit. Four students have enrolled for the new ASD Unit for September, the unit will hold a maximum of 6 students per class. One class will commence in September 2022 and the second one will commence in September 2023.
- Between the ASD unit and SEN, approximately 6.5 teachers will be taken up from the allocation on.
- Additional accommodation will be provided for the ASD unit. The current proposal is to temporarily convert the Guidance Room, the Guidance office and the First Aid room and use it as the ASD unit in Year 1. Room 1 will be added to this in Year 2
- Temporary classroom accommodation will be provided to cover these two rooms and these will be located at the rear of the building.

- 1st year enrolment for the 2022/2023 school year is 85 students.
- The TY trip to Delphi will take place from Wed 27th to Fri 29th April. S.Magennis C.Sherry, F.Ward and D.Mone will accompany the students on the trip.
